The Consul General's Office in Toronto wishes to inform Sri Lankan pensioners that Life/Residence Certificates for the year 2025, will be accepted for attestation by the Consulate until March 31, 2025, subject to the release of the new version, by the Department of Pensions Sri Lanka, on December 01, 2024.

1. Only ONE Life/Residence Certificate per pensioner, per calendar year, will be issued. Hence, should the pensioner have more than one pension such as Civil, W & O. P., and/or Local Government, all pension numbers should be written clearly in the appropriate columns on the same Life/Residence Certificate.
2. Place your signature in category 03 (front page down) and the Declaration category on the reverse side of the Life/Residence Certificate – 2025. Together with the duly filled LRC, attach copies of the photo page of your Sri Lankan or Canadian **Valid Passport**. No expired passports will be accepted according to Circular 01/2018.
3. Upon receipt of your LRC at the Mobile Service, the Original will be attested and returned to you immediately, to be forwarded by you to the required destinations as follows.

i. Pensioners Residing Permanently in Canada.

Please scan and email LRC 2025 to the Department of Pensions at foreignpension@pensions.gov.lk.

ii. Pensioners Residing Temporarily in Canada.


Please forward LRC 2025 to your designated Divisional Secretary's Office or as instructed by your pay office.

4. Those who are unable to visit the mobile service or the Consulate in person are kindly requested to send their LRC and a copy of the valid passport, with the Medical Doctor's attestation and official seal/stamp affixed, together with a self-addressed stamped envelope by mail only, to the following address.

5. The applicant will be verified from a video call or site visit by the Consul General personally. Upon satisfaction, the LRC will be signed and mailed back.
6. Life Certificates for Banks and Transfers etc.; do not form part of the free pension service. Hence, Pensioners should download and use forms from designated bank websites, have the documents attested by bank-designated signatories, mentioned on the Life Certificate/documents, and forward the same to the corresponding banks. If the bank insists on attestation by the Consulate General, the requirement will be a Consular matter with mandatory procedures to be followed, and applicable Consular fees to be paid. Complete details could be obtained from the "Certification Officer".
